

Field Service Technician / Door & Hardware Installer

Job Description

This is a full-time, year-round position. You will be an important part of our company, at **Orience Integration**. Job Duties

Evaluate and thoroughly document on site verification. Be responsible for and coordinate vehicle and tool upkeep with company mechanic. Load products as required. Capable of technical support and troubleshooting electrified hardware for access control. Occasionally perform on site welding and bondo work on steel frames. Comply with all company occupational health and safety policies.

Job Requirements/Skills

- Basic carpentry experience needed to install doors and door hardware.
- Electrical experience needed to install and troubleshoot electronic access control systems.
- Be a good “communicator” between customer and service manager. This is crucial.
- Good mechanical aptitude.
- Familiarity with tools. (both hand tools and power tools – Provided by company)
- Welding experience (light gauge metals) considered an asset.
- Ability to lift 50 – 75 pounds.
- Responsible and able to work with others as well as on your own.
